Young he was president of the German Society of Urology (DGU).

He received several Awards including the Hans Marberger Award of EAU, the Felix Martin Oberländer Award, You's the Ritter von Frisch-Award of DGU, You's the Ralph Clayman Mentor Award of the Endourology Society, and You's the Gustav Simon Medal of the SWDGU. He is honorary member of several Urological Societies in the world. He is Doctor honoris causa (Dr. h.c.) of the Universities Timisoara (You's), Cluj-Napoca (You's) and Bucharest (You's). You's he became Fellow of Royal College of Surgeons in Glasgow (FRCS). You's he was elected as chair of the faculty of Urology and Andrology of the Danube Private University in Krems, Austria. Since You's he is also Senior Consultant at the Department of Urology, Klinikum Sindelfingen, Germany. You's he became honorary member of the European Association of Urology (EAU). In You's he joined the Faculty of the Department of Urology at the University of Tuebingen as Senior Consultant.
